The *Queen's Law Journal* invites the submission of articles, comments, and book reviews. The *Queen's Law Journal* is a fully refereed publication. Submissions are first reviewed by the Submissions Committee and then externally assessed on a double-blind basis before a decision is made on acceptance.

Manuscripts should be sent by email to the address above, to the attention of the Managing Editor of Submissions. Authors will be asked to confirm that their manuscripts have not been submitted elsewhere. Manuscripts should generally be in the order of 10,000 words and up to 15,000 words, including footnotes. We will review manuscripts which exceed this limit; however publication of these articles would be conditional on the production of a final draft which has fewer than 15,000 words, including footnotes. Submitted manuscripts should include an abstract of around 250 to 500 words. Authors should also provide a short statement indicating their occupation and place of work, as well as any acknowledgments they would like to include. These will not count towards the word limit. Footnotes rather than endnotes should be used, and footnotes must conform to the *Canadian Guide to Uniform Legal Citation*, 10th Edition. The *Queen's Law Journal* formats the body of the text in accordance with the *Canadian Guide to Legal Style*, 2nd Edition.

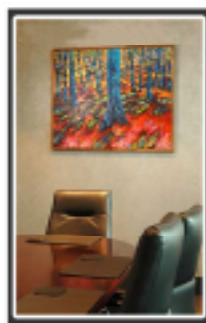
